During the spring of 2016, the Iowa Legislature passed House File 2433 expanding exemptions on supplies and consumables for manufacturers. In October, the Iowa Department of Revenue passed ARC 2768C which further clarified the law and expanded the new rule.

This law has greatly expanded current exemptions contained in Iowa Code by exempting supplies and by defining replacement parts which has significant, positive impact on Iowa manufacturers and producers.
