The value of real exports in lowa have remained higher than real imports. This gives the state a trade surplus.




17% of the state's demand for manufactured goods was met through imports.





Insourced manufacturing jobs in lowa have been on a steady rise. The value peaked at 36,500 jobs. (2022)







